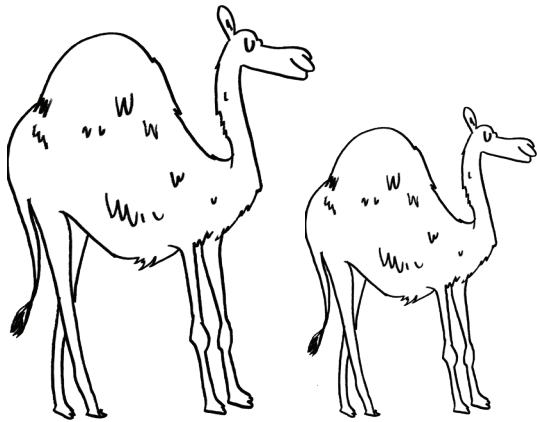


Rebekah and Isaac
